





Share 2 Act Project Launched

The Project will produce a Manual on Best Practices for professionals working in the field of drugs and addictions

The Erasmus + Project "Share2Act" has now started! The project is aimed at enhancing the skills and competences of professionals working in the field of drugs and addictions through the exchange of best practices in prevention, treatment, social inclusion, harm reduction and other tools.

During its implementation period, the partners will collect best practices for both drug consumption and addictive behaviours. The main outcome of the project will be the publication of the Manual of Best Practices for Professionals Working with People with Problematic Consumption of Drugs and/or Addictions, which is intended to be a practical and useful document with at least 25 best practices with a practical approach and a methodology that assures the high quality and innovativeness of the practices. The S2A Manual will be online edited and will be disseminated in more than 1,000 organisations in Europe and Latin America, taking advantage of the networks of the partners.

The project consortium is made up of 4 partners, led by the <u>Ibero-American Network of NGOs Working in</u> the <u>Fields of Drugs and Addictions</u> (RIOD), and partners are <u>Correlation</u> (European Harm Reduction Network), <u>Federación Enlace</u> (Spain), and <u>FEDITO-BXL</u> (Belgium).

The first meeting of the project was held on 9 February, in a virtual format due to the Covid19 pandemic, where the main milestones of the project and the best way to collect best practices were discussed, based on the interests and needs of each project partner.

From now until July, the best practices will be collected by the partners, evaluated and included in the S2A Manual,



which will be published during August and September. The Manual is expected to be presented in October, in Madrid, in the framework of the final meeting of the project.

Another important outcome is the SHARE 2 ACT Project' Website, which will be the information hub of the project, as well as the repository for the S2A Manual and any other material from the project. In the coming weeks the S2A' Website will be launched.
